

ST. IRENE 40-HOUR DEVOTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT Sunday, March 10th through Tuesday, March 12th



The 40-Hour Devotion runs from 11am Sunday, March 10th through 8:15am Tuesday, March 12th, when a Mass of Thanksgiving with Solemn Benediction is offered as the Blessed Sacrament is Reposed. Each hour of the Devotion is dedicated to a Special Prayer Intention (see below), along with the private Prayer Intentions of Adorers. The Public Prayer segments (**bolded**) that begin some of the Hours will vary in length depending upon the Prayer; with the remaining time of those Hours devoted to quiet, uninterrupted <u>Prayerful Meditation</u>.
