Aug. 2—National Night Out Against Crime 2016, Cerny Park




National Night Out Against






Aug. 13—Pulling Weeds at City Signs

Report from DD Jim Bartz

Brother Knights,

Our ceremonies are changing for this coming year. Our degrees will no longer be called 1st, 2nd and 3rd along with the Patriotic degree. They will now be known as the

now be called medals of office. And our officer installation will be changed for this coming year. More of this will be discussed at our council meetings.

I also would like to recap some of the successes of the fraternal year and changes for the coming year. I'm happy to report that what we do does make a difference in this world.

First off, it was an excellent year of growth with an increase of 30,000 new members (2 million Brother Knights total) along with 292 new counsels. This resulted in 72 million volunteer man hours along with \$174 million dollars in donations to charities. In addition to that 9 million dollars were donated for the Christian relief fund, which helps persecuted Christians in the Middle East.

Another success of this past year is that we have had 40 Circle of Honor awards, whereas we have averaged only 25 in past years. A Circle of Honor award is when Supreme Council sets goals for membership growth for each state. Sadly, Illinois was not one of them. Our goal was 2,500 new members and we achieved only 2,409. We needed just 91 more new members to make Circle of Honor

As you can see we have had great success this past year and there will be changes to help us grow and be successful as Knights of Columbus.
