I'm reminded of the old Chinese curse, may you live in interesting times.


We certainly live in an interesting time. Whether it is a curse or opportunity is up to us.

We don't depend on political leaders. We do it ourselves, person to person. We are consistently pro-life, because we're consistently pro-love.


