#### Feb. 7, 2021—Virtual KC Super Bowl Raffle & Party

If you have not yet, consider participating in the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Knights of Columbus Super Bowl Raffle to be on Feb. 7,

2021 during the Super Bowl game. The Raffle is a major fundraiser for the St. Irene Knights of Columbus Council. It is a 50-50 cash raffle with half of the proceeds awarded to participants, and the other half retained by the local Council to be used for programs that benefit the St. Irene's Parish and community outreach programs.

The raffle and the ticket sales continue to be conducted virtually. Multimedia will be used to communicate event including the church bulletin, email, St. Irene Knights of Columbus web site and Facebook page.

Buy your raffle tickets early to take advantage of two early drawings. PGK Marc Alleruzzo won the first drawing held on Jan. 24. The second drawing will be held at Noon on Jan. 31 (join by Zoom). Early bird raffle winners remain eligible for drawings on Super Bowl Sunday.

As in previous years, the raffle is based on purchasing squares in three separate football pools.

For the Faith and Hope Pools the tickets are \$25 per square, and for the Charity pool the tickets are \$50 ticket per square. Download the ticket order form this link: <u>ticket form</u>. The squares and numbers for each ticket are assigned randomly. Cash prizes ranging from \$25 to \$500 will be awarded throughout the football game on Super Bowl Sunday.

### St. Irene Grade School to Close

On Jan. 8, **Fr. Clive** announced that the St. Irene Grade school will close at the end of the 2020-2021 school year. He stated "This is a letter that no pastor wants to write. As you are aware, St. Irene School has struggled for years. Low enrollment numbers have forced a greater reliance on the parish subsidy to support the school. The challenges of COVID have only intensified the enrollment concerns.

After consultation with the Diocesan Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer, the recommendation to suspend operations was made. **Bishop Hicks** has accepted that recommendation."

Early-Bird Drawings: Drawings will be held virtually Jan. 24 & 31 at St. Irene's. Each entry can only win once during the early-bird drawings, but remains eligible for the drawings on Super Bowl Sunday, Feb. 7, 2021.

Raffle on Super Bowl Sunday: Prior to the start of the football game, for each respective pool 100 number pairs will be randomly assigned to each raffle ticket holder, from (0,0) through (9,9). During the football game, one cash prize will be awarded to the person holding the winning number pair each time a team scores; a touchdown plus points after constitutes one score. The winning number pair is comprised as follows: the least significant digit (right most digit) in the NFC team score constitutes the first number, and the least significant digit of the AFC team constitutes the second number in the pair. The cash prize amount is determined by a random drawing from the available cash prize pool. The remainder, if any, at the game's end will be awarded by random drawing of those raffle tickets not having a winning combination during the football game.

The pool of 17 cash prizes are based on 100 tickets sold for each pool. The number of cash prizes and the total cash amount awarded may be reduced to maintain the same winning odds (0.17) and 50% payout of ticket receipts. In the event of multiple raffles being conducted, cash prizes may be pooled. Fifty percent of the raffle ticket receipts will be used to support St. Irene Knights of Columbus programs.


