Annual Memorial High School Scholarship—Applications Due May 12

We are pleased to announce that two \$1000 scholarships are available to benefit two students attending a Catholic High School or College.

Eligible students must be affiliated with the St. Irene Parish community as a registered parishioner, member of a registered family, or grandchildren of a registered family. Students who had attended St. Irene Grade School are also eligible.

We congratulate those who choose to attend a Catholic high school or college. Students must be enrolled and plan to attend in the Fall, 2023. The \$1000 award is to be used to help defray tuition costs. The scholarship is competitive and is awarded based on the student's service to the Church, School, and Community. Priority will be given to students who will be attending high school in their first year.

Between now and June 30 I will be identifying all of the new officers for the year of 2023-2024. If anybody is interested in becoming an office, please feel free to come and talk to me.


I know that the Fourth-of-July is three months away, but I will keep on saying please come be a part of the help. The money from those two days is donated to many different things.

ASAP (Aid and Support After Pregnancy)

The ASAP is a Supreme Council program. The brochure states:

"Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP), describes the Knights of Columbus' efforts to support pregnant women, mothers and their babies by serving pregnancy resource centers and maternity homes.

Through ASAP, for every \$500 a council or assembly donates to a qualifying non-profit pregnancy resource center or maternity home, the Supreme Council will issue a \$100 grant to the same qualifying organization.

There are a variety of activities you can organize to qualify for ASAP funds – most fall within the categories of financial support and material assistance:

- Financial Support includes: direct donations, Baby Bottle Drives, proceeds from fundraisers, open houses, etc.
- Material Assistance includes: donations of baby items (equipment, food, formula, diapers, wipes), clothes (maternity, baby, infant and toddler) and other items often listed on a center's or maternity home's website."

The Waterleaf Women's Center, Aurora, is listed as a qualified organization. They provide medical information and provide counseling, community resource assistance, and adoption information and referral. They educate young adults on the impact of unhealthy lifestyle choices in an effort to prevent the need for our services.

I recommend that our Council offer \$500 support to Waterleaf. A lesser amount, I am sure would also be welcome.


Mar. 17—Council Hosts Soup Supper


