The **date has changed to July 15** in order to not conflict with the funeral for Suzanne Cirock. he Council takes on the task of maintaining perennial plant-



Hello everyone, and welcome to July! It's summer! We made it! Some of you might be sad about that, but I like summer, so it's good for me.




