Sept. 15-17—Council Knights to Conduct the Intellectual Disabilities "Tootsie Roll" Fund Drive —Goal is \$7500

People with Intellectual Disabilities (ID) have limitations in intellectual functions like communicating, taking care of themselves, and impaired social skills. Depending on the level of impairment, many with ID live in special facilities

and group homes. Although they are state-supported, funding is limited. Annually, the Knights of Columbus conduct a fund drive to help support organizations that offer service to people with ID. Our Council has conducted this fund drive every year since its founding in 1975.

An In-Person Street Collection September 15-16—Volunteers are needed to be on the streets with their "Tootsie Rolls". Parishioners 18 years or older are also welcome to volunteer. Half the money raised will be donated to the Cupertino Group Home in Warrenville (a <u>Clare Woods Academy</u> operated facility, Carol Stream). The remaining half will be split between <u>Western DuPage Special Recreation Association</u>, <u>Special Camps for Special People</u> of Winfield, and <u>Illinois Knights of Columbus Charities</u>. Except for the candy cost, 100% of the money raised is donated to the designated organizations.

We urge you to support the fund drive by volunteering or donating generously either online or getting a Tootsie Roll on the street.

ProLife St Michael's in Wheaton

This past summer was a very busy period with multiple local events as well as ones in Springfield and in downtown Chicago. Efforts were made to speak out against, both before and after the recently enacted SB 1909 bill by **Governor Pritzker**, which is intended to cripple Pregnancy Centers from actually giving women a right to choose something other than abortion. The other side claims to be pro-choice, but God forbid if that choice is not to have an abortion.

Fortunately, Pro-Life advocates are making serious headway to block this legislation. The law "is both stupid and very likely unconstitutional," federal **Judge Lain Johnston** wrote in an Aug. 4 order granting a preliminary injunction. "It is stupid because its own supporter admitted it was unneeded" and had no evidence supporting its claims of deception, he wrote. "It is likely unconstitutional because it is a blatant example of government taking the side of whose speech is sanctionable and whose speech is immunized." We will watch how this progresses.


