ProLife ASAP "Pass The Hat" Incentive

Life proponents are often criticized for opposing abortion while not supporting new mothers and their babies. This is where the Knights step into the breach. The **Aid and Support After Pregnancy** (ASAP) program is our answer, and the Order has a goal of providing \$5M to resource centers and maternity homes this year. Let's "Pass the Hat" and provide the benefit to centers in Illinois.

Supreme is now featuring an ASAP "Pass the Hat" incentive.

Local councils may make donations and claim ASAP participation as a life program activity on their SP7 awards input form. However, they may not submit an ASAP grant application for their "pass the hat" contributions.

Supreme will match 25% of the funds raised up to a maximum of \$10,000 from Supreme for \$50,000 raised. Supreme's matching funds will be made payable to the PRCs and/or MHs selected by the state council. The check will be sent to the address provided by the state council on the State Convention ASAP Application.

Your council can now donate online or during the upcoming State Convention to help achieve this goal.

I recommend that the Council contribute \$250 to this very worthy cause. Last year we contributed \$250 to Waterleaf to complete our SP7 submission.


